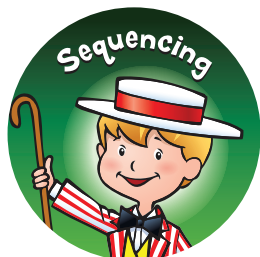

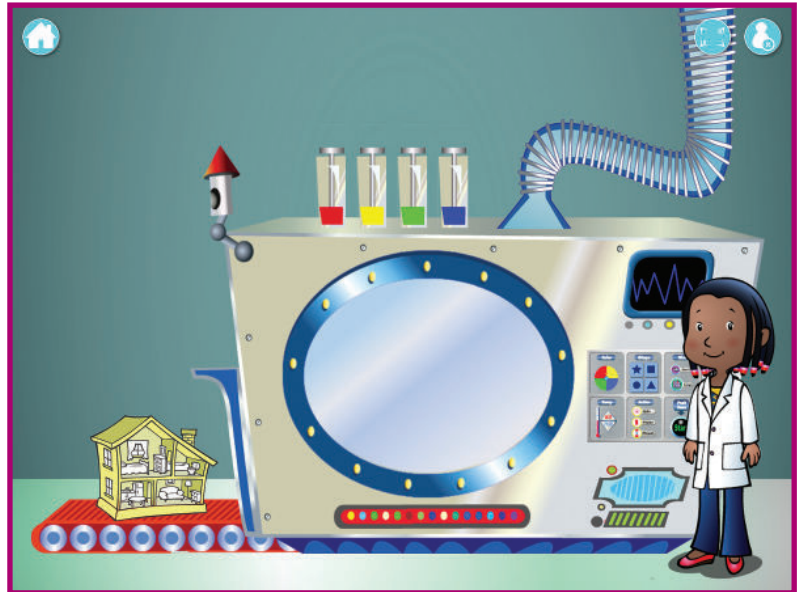

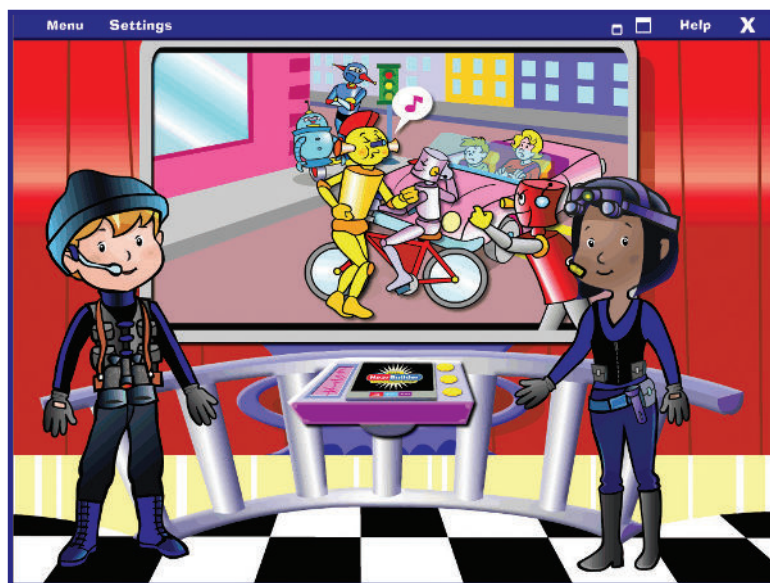

WHAT IS AUDITORY MEMORY?

Auditory memory is the ability to take in information that is presented orally, process it, retain it in one's mind, and then recall it. Auditory memory requires working memory and also involves the skills of attending, listening, processing, storing, and recalling.

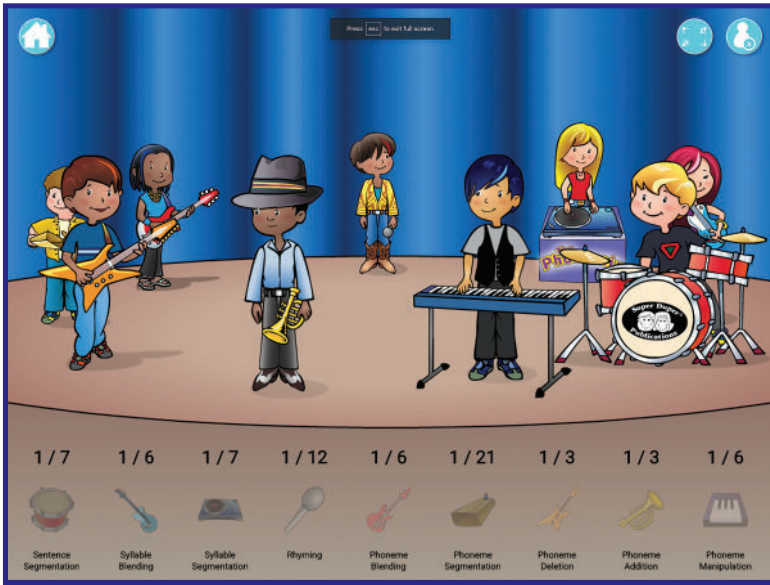
WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

In the classroom, students must remember multi-step directions, relate new information to prior knowledge, comprehend oral language, take notes while listening, and be able to talk and write clearly.

HearBuilder Auditory Memory targets:

- Memory for Numbers (3–7 digits)
- Memory for Words (3–5 words organized by syllable)
- Memory for Details (3–7 details)
- Auditory Closure (Sentence Completion)

Children must be **aware of sounds** in language **to read and spell.**

1 SYLLABLES & SENTENCES

First, students practice foundational phonological awareness activities like sentence segmentation, syllable blending, and syllable segmentation.

2 RHYMING & PHONEMES

Next, they move to more challenging activities such as rhyming, phoneme blending, phoneme segmentation and phoneme identification.

3 ADVANCED PHONEMES

Finally, in *HearBuilder Phonological Awareness* students practice more difficult phonemic awareness tasks including phoneme deletion, phoneme addition, and phoneme manipulation.

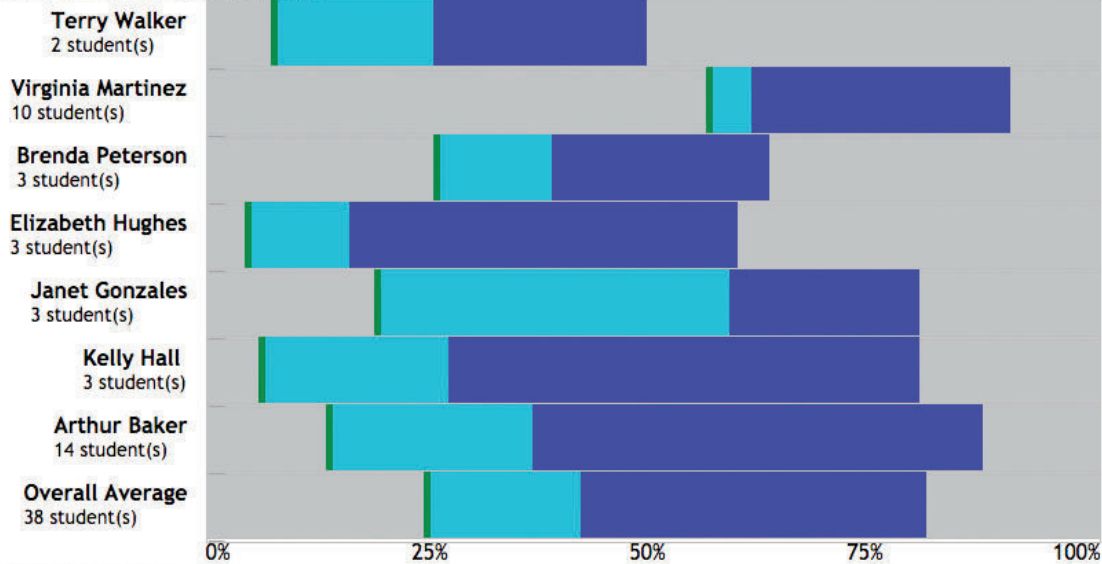

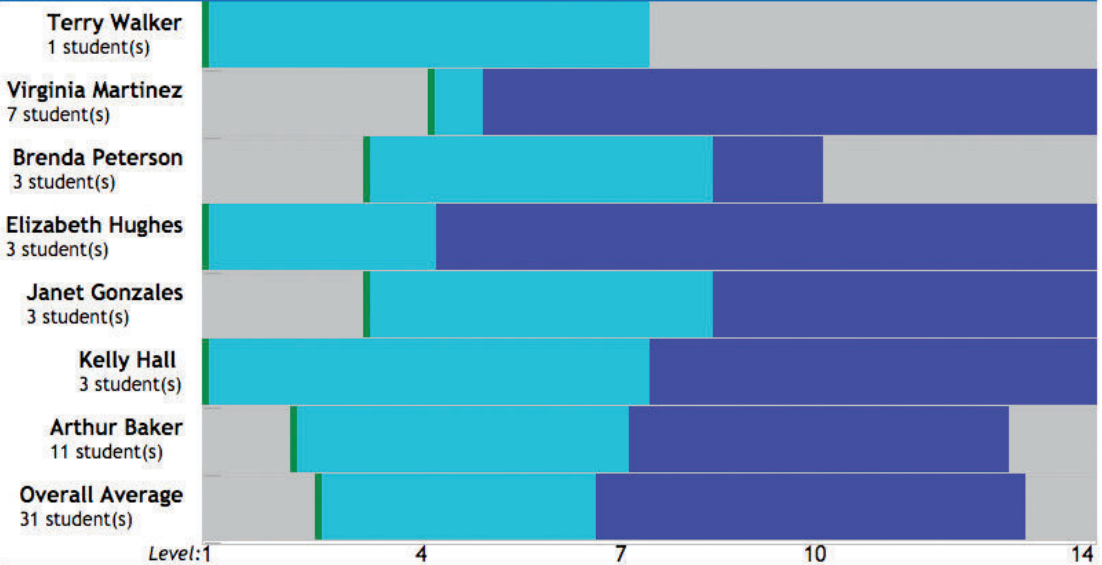

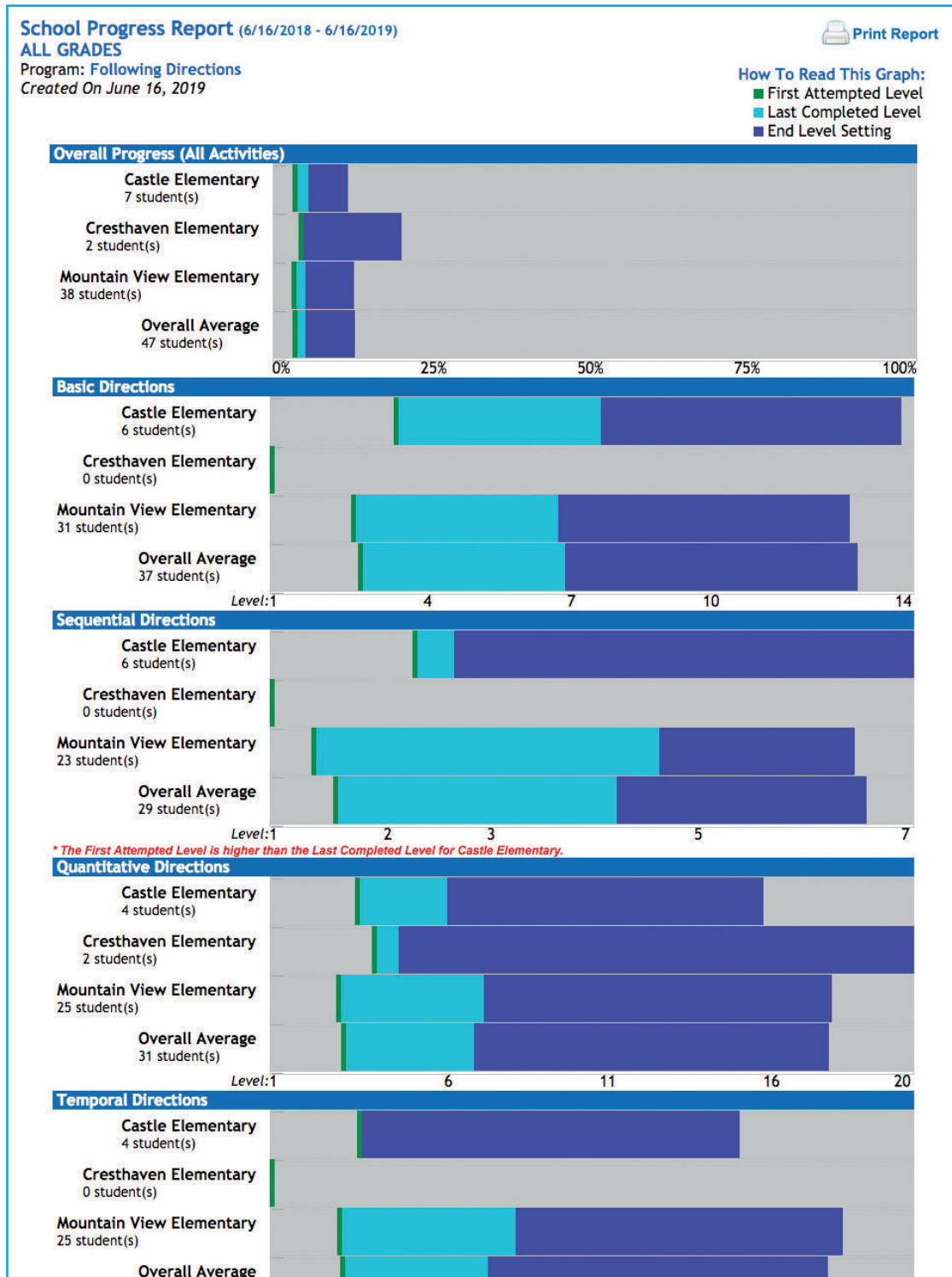

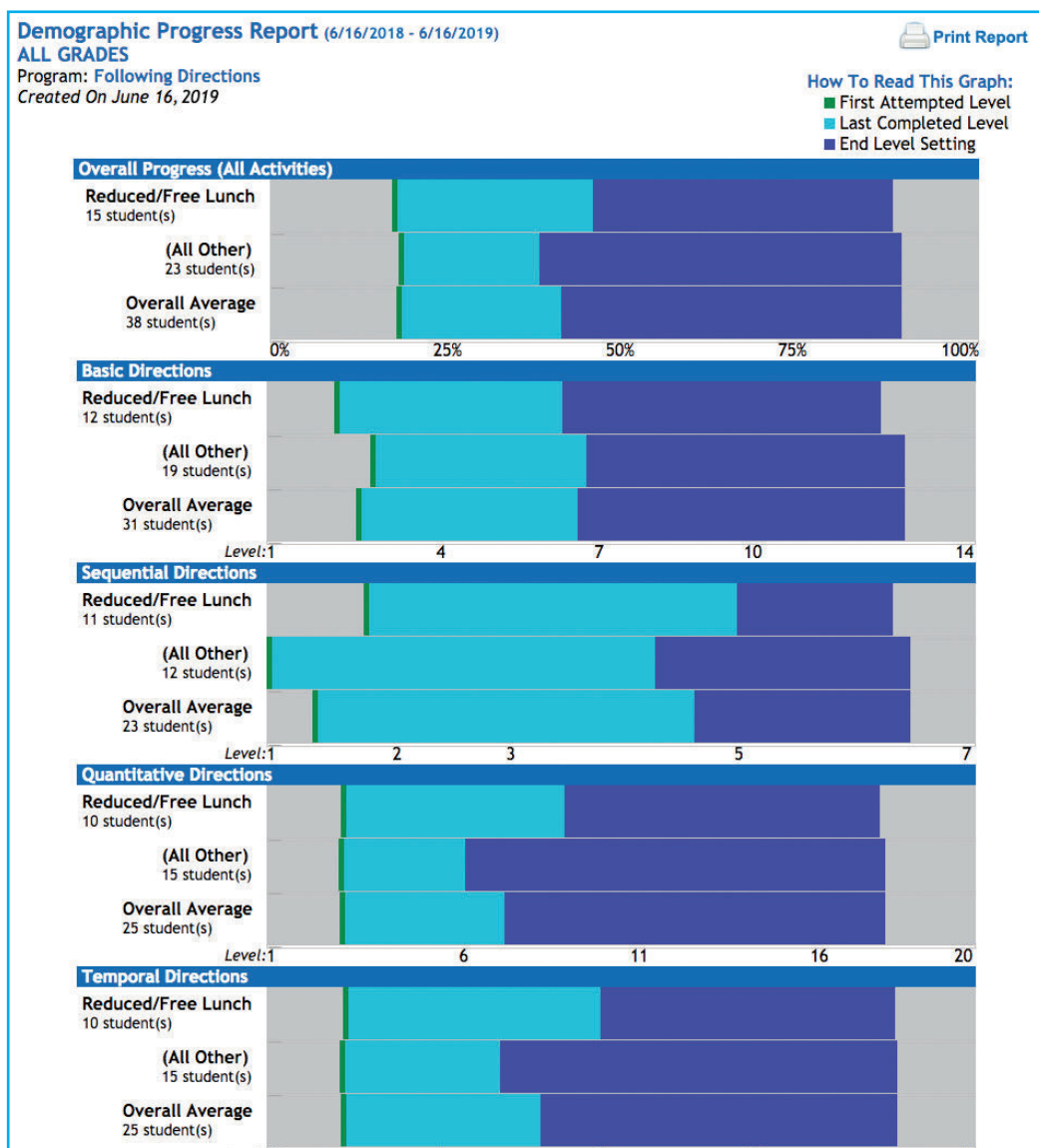

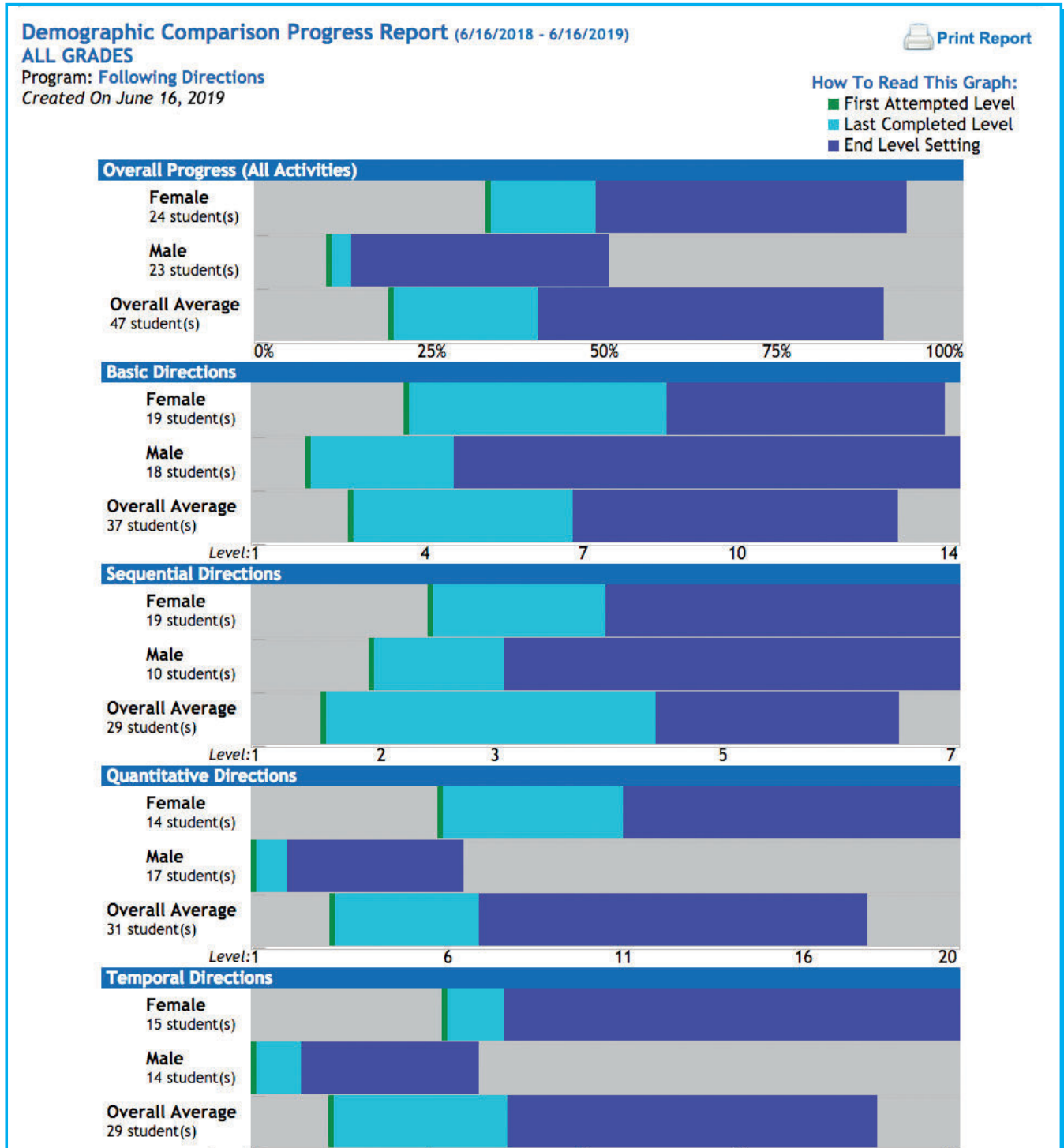

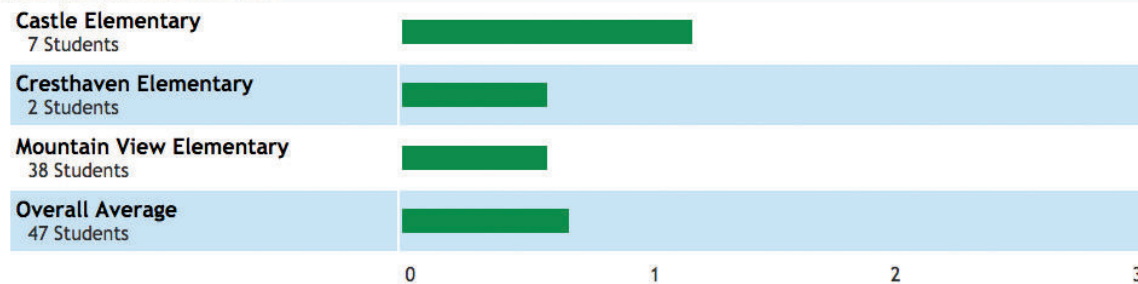
